MEMORY VERSE TOKENS

Duplicate the memory verse tokens (masters found on pages 10 and 11), making one token for each student in your class.

MEMORY VERSE POSTER

Enlarge and color the poster on page 12 or enlarge the poster on page 13 to use for teaching the memory verse.

REVIEW: This Is a Test

Depending upon the age of your group, you may want to give them a written test when you have completed teaching this volume. Make a copy of the handout from page 4 for each student in your class.

Lesson 1

THE ENEMY OF THE NEW KING

DISCUSSION: Wrong or Right

Materials Needed: A picture or cartoon showing someone doing a sinful act (fighting, stealing, etc.), a picture of Jesus doing good (teaching, healing, etc.)

Directions: Ask the students to look at the picture of someone doing a sinful act. Ask the following questions:

1. What do you see in the picture?
2. How do you feel when you see what is happening?
3. What would you do if you were the person in the picture?
4. What do you think you would say to the person in the picture?
5. What does this statement mean to you: "We often sin."

Show the picture of Jesus. Use the first four questions from above to review Jesus' life. Change the ending of the last question to read: "Jesus never did anything wrong (sin)."

MEMORY VERSE HUNT: 1 John 4:4

Materials Needed: Twenty-five 3" x 5" index cards.

Prepare: Copy each word of 1 John 4:4 on a separate 3" x 5" card. Hide the 25 cards in the room before the session begins.

Directions: Tell students that a memory verse is hidden in the room, and ask them to find it (a word card at a time) and return the cards to the table in correct word order. When all the cards have been found and positioned correctly, read the verse aloud for all the class to hear.

REVIEW: True or False

Materials Needed: Red and green sheets of 9" x 12" construction paper, glue, black marker.

Prepare: Cut paper in half to make 9" x 6" signs. On green paper, write *True*. On red paper, write *False*. Prepare a red and green sign for each student.

Directions: Read a numbered statement (#1-10, see below). On the word *Go*, the students are to show the green sign if the statement is true or the red sign if it is false. Ask students to correct statements which are not true.

1. King Herod said, "There will be no other king to take my place." (*True*)
2. Satan tried to destroy Jesus by having King Herod kill all children two years old and younger. (*True*)
3. God protected baby Jesus by sending Him and His parents to Jerusalem. (*False: Egypt*)
4. Teachers at the Temple were amazed at how much Jesus knew and understood. (*True*)
5. Satan loved Jesus. (*False: hated*)
6. Jesus was always good and never sinned. (*True*)
7. Satan's desire is to have us obey God rather than him. (*False: to obey him rather than God*)
8. Jesus obeyed God and Satan. (*False: obeyed God only*)
9. God is greater than Satan. (*True*)
10. I can ask God to help me to be obedient in all things. (*True*)

Lesson 2

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD JESUS AND HIS TEMPTATION

SCRIPTURE MATCHUP: Who Is Greater?

Materials Needed: Construction paper, glue, yarn, clothespins.

Prepare: Enlarge pages 5 and 6 so that each section fits on an 8½" x 11" sheet of paper: Cut apart and glue together as indicated on thumbnail.
